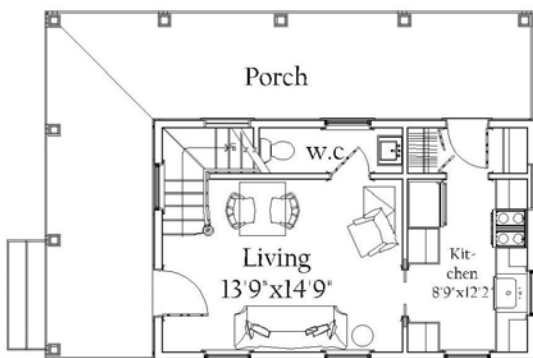
Western Reserve Cottage



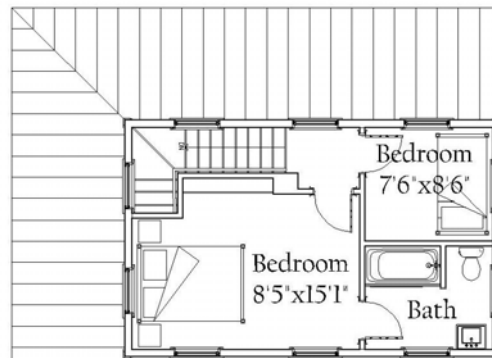
